**Georgetown's Annual Tree Lighting Ceremony**  
*On December 2, see the lights of Georgetown as Washington Harbour hosts

**Washington, DC, November 19, 2007** – On Sunday, December 2, from 4 to 7 p.m., enjoy historic Georgetown with a festival of lights as the Georgetown Business Improvement District (BID) and the Washington Harbour host the second annual tree lighting ceremony together with the sixth annual Parade of Lights with music and holiday fare.

Located on Georgetown's waterfront (*3000 K Street, NW*), the festivities begin at 4 p.m. where guests can share holiday wishes with Father Christmas, create snowflakes, decorate holiday cookies, enjoy a champagne celebration at Roche Salon, or warm up with Starbucks' gingerbread lattes. Bring a new and unwrapped toy to place under Georgetown's tree to benefit Toys for Tots. At 5:30 p.m., the Parade of Lights will float by on the Potomac River and at 6 p.m., special guests illuminate Georgetown's tree.

After the lighting, sit down to a prix-fixed holiday dinner offered by many of the Harbour restaurants including Cabanas, Tony & Joe's, Agraria, Nick's Riverside Grille, and Bangkok Joe's.
